RE: DESIGNATION OF CHILD PROTECTION ORGANISATION: BADISA

This letter serves as a confirmation that **BADISA** has been designated as a Child Protection Organisation (CPO) in terms of section 107 of the Children's Act 38 of 2005 to render services as described in Section 105 (5) (a-f).

BADISA is designated for a period of five (5) years with effect from **01 April 2020 to 31 March 2025**.

As a designated CPO, **BADISA** must be managed and maintained in accordance with the Children's Act and must comply with the prescribed national norms and standards contemplated in section 106 of the Children's Act and such other requirements as may be prescribed.

In terms of section 109 of the Children's Act, the designation, as confirmed in this letter, may be withdrawn to perform any, or any specific, designated child protection service, if **BADISA**

- (i) breaches or fails to comply with any conditions subject to which the designation was made or
- (ii) contravenes or fails to comply with a provisions of the Children's Act, or
- (iii) if it is in the best interest of the protection of children.

The following Badisa Management Programmes are able to render Adoption services:

1. Beaufort West
2. Magdalena Huis
3. Koue Bokkeveld
4. Swellendam
5. Hermanus, Standford and Gansbaai
6. Family Care Services Knysna
7. Stilbaai
8. West Coast (Weskus)

Please take note that the application for re-designation must be done in writing 90 days before the expiry of the period of designation, to the Provincial Head of Social Development.
